



CENTRAL CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL DANCE CONTRACT

Students and Parents,

All students attending the CCHS Homecoming Dance on Saturday, October 25th, 2025 are expected to:

- Read through the CCHS dance policy and expectations carefully. Sign this contract stating that you have read and agree to adhere to the CCHS dance policy and have a parent/guardian sign this contract stating that they have read and agree to the CCHS dance policy.
- Have your date sign this contract stating that he/she has read and agrees to adhere to the CCHS dance policy.
- Tickets prices are \$25.00 per student. All students must return payment together with this signed contract to the CCHS Dean of Students no later than after school on Wed, October 22nd. No student, or any student's date, will be permitted into the dance without this signed contract. All guests must be either current high school students or only one year out of high school to attend.

SCHOOL DANCE POLICY

School dances provide an opportunity for students to socialize in a safe atmosphere. All students are expected to adhere to the following CCHS Dance policy:

- Dress and behave in an appropriate manner. Students must not wear apparel that reveals visible cleavage or undergarments. Tight and extremely form fitting apparel is not allowed.
- All dances hosted by Central Catholic High School are open to Central Catholic students and one guest only.
- Before each dance, students and one parent must have signed and submitted a dance contract. If the student plans to bring a guest, that guest must also sign a dance contract, and the contract must be upheld on the part of the student and his or her guest.
- The CCHS student is responsible for his/her guest's behavior. CCHS administrators consider the guest's speech, dress, and conduct as an extension of the CCHS student. All students and their guests must stay at the dance until 10:00 pm.
- All school rules remain in effect. **This Homecoming Dance will be held in the Pine Room @ Oglebay Resort.**
- Students and guests are expected to respect themselves and each other. Lewd and/or vulgar dancing or conduct is disrespectful, offensive and will not be tolerated. All dance styles must comply with standards of Christian morality, including modesty and safety. School personnel will be the final judge of the appropriateness of the dance style. The following will be strictly prohibited: Grinding (front to back dancing), dancing in a tight group, suggestive or dangerous dancing. Dancing in a manner deemed unacceptable by the school dance chaperones will follow a three strikes policy. Strike 1: warning Strike 2: timeout Strike 3: immediate removal from the dance. The chaperones will notify the parent/guardian of the violation and dismissal from dance. No refund will be issued. Students dismissed from the dance will not be permitted to attend the next school dance. Students in violation of these or any school policies may also be subject to school disciplinary procedures.
- Use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco is not permitted. Before entering and departing the dance, all students will be subject to alcohol screenings. If a positive reading is found in the course of a screening, the student will be immediately removed from the activity and the parents and proper authorities will be notified. The student will be subject to further disciplinary action as a result. If a guest registers a positive reading, both the student and the guest will be removed from the activity and parents will be notified. Any violation of the dance policy will result in notification of parents who will be asked to pick up the student at the dance. It may also result in suspension of future extracurricular activities
